



ADULT CLASS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read all Terms and Conditions carefully. By enrolling at Ecole Performing Arts ("Ecole") for an Adult Class, it is assumed that you have read, understood and agreed to the following terms and conditions.

1 To attend our Adult Beginner or Elementary Ballet classes you must be registered via our Enrolment platform and a casual class pass purchased or have an active 5 or 10 class pass.

2 Adult Ballet classes require an Electronic Class Pass to be purchased after your initial casual visit, if you wish to continue. 5 class passes are valid for three months and 10 class passes are valid for six months. Four additional weeks will be added to passes that are purchased in November and December due to some weeks that classes don't run in the December and January holiday period. Extensions to the expiry date of the 5 or 10 passes will not be given unless a Doctors certificate is provided in the case of an injury that prevents you from dancing for an extended period.

3 Dance Class passes are to be used by the person registered to the pass. Passes are non-transferable.

4 No refunds will be given for any unused portion of the 5 or 10 Class Pass. If you purchase a casual visit and are unable to attend, please contact us to re-schedule your casual class within three months of the date of purchase. A casual class purchased and not used is non-refundable.

5. Payment for the Class Pass must be made before you can attend again after your initial casual class. Further casual classes may be booked if you don't wish to purchase a Class Pass.

6. Ecole retains the right to change the day and time of the Adult Beginner and Elementary classes. Sufficient notice of any change will be given to all students with an active Class Pass.

7. Health of a Student

We accept students on the assumption that they are in good health and fitness and may participate in dance activities at the studio. Tuition in dance entails physical exertion and that whilst all Ecole staff take every precaution, the risk of injury cannot be eliminated.

It is your responsibility upon enrolling in the Adult Classes to notify staff of any injury, medical condition or allergy suffered by the student that may prevent him/her from engaging in certain physical exercises or routines. Students are permitted to bring water into the studios.

If you have any health or medical concerns you must discuss them with your doctor before participating in dance classes at Ecole. You acknowledge that Ecole does not give you any medical advice.

Ecole warns that whilst you are on our premises and participating in recreational activities, you are at risk of suffering physical harm or personal injury including broken bones, soft tissue injuries, joint injuries, etc

In case of an emergency requiring urgent medical attention, the undersigned hereby authorises the staff of Ecole to seek medical attention.

By accepting these Terms & Conditions, you agree that Ecole will not be liable for personal injury or illness suffered on premises or from using our facilities.

8. Physical Contact in the Performing Arts

Some physical contact may be necessary by a member of the faculty to demonstrate technique or exercise – or if First Aid is to be administered.
